

Middle School Dance Behavior Expectations

While middle school dances are intended to be fun, students must remember they are still inside Saint Mary's School and St. Mary's Church and should behave accordingly. Behavior expectations include the following:

1. Respect others.
2. Respect others' belongings.
3. Respect the property of the school, church, and outside vendors.
4. Respect the chaperones and school staff.
5. No running.
6. No throwing food or drink.
7. Sit on seats, not on tables or windowsills.
8. The area behind the dividers is off limits.
9. Bathrooms are for using the bathroom, not for congregating or socializing.
10. Students are to remain in the building during the dances. They may wait in the school foyer for a ride or if a quiet place is needed to make a phone call.
11. Always behave in a manner appropriate for a student of Saint Mary's School or a parishioner of St. Mary's Church.

If a student fails to obey these rules after warnings by the chaperones or staff, the student's parents will be called so the student can be taken home.
