Living the Masculine in the Fire of the Spirit

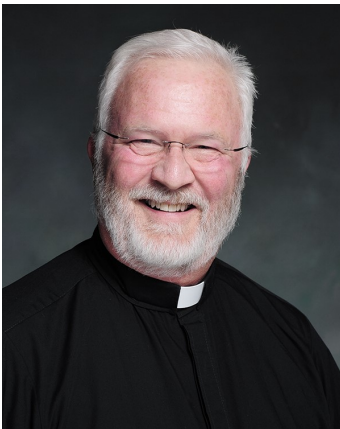
A Retreat for Men
