

Reopening at-a-glance

Returning to face-to-face instruction requires much reflection and purposeful planning. Below you will find details which highlight our plans for a safe return to school.



Entrance protocols

- Temperature scans and screening
- Face coverings
- Hand sanitizing stations
- Staggered arrival times

Cleaning protocols

- Each classroom equipped with hospital-grade disinfectant solution
- Regular hand washing schedules and practices
- Regular bathroom cleaning throughout the day
- Frequent disinfecting of high touch areas (handrails, door knobs, bottle fill stations, etc)
- Nightly hospital-grade cleaning solution sprayed in each room
- Use of a Clorox 360 electrostatic sprayer for increased disinfection

Social Distancing

- Markings placed in common areas for visual reminders of physical distancing
- Markers placed on classroom floors to identify desk placement
- Lunch in classrooms, outside or in cafe on rotating basis reducing numbers at lunch time
- Redefining recess spaces to allow for physically distanced activities
- New mass schedule to lessen numbers and increase physical distancing

Supporting Catholic Identity

- Continued celebration of the Eucharist during mass with new mass schedule
- Continued religious studies in elementary classes
- Continued scheduling of religion classes in the middle school
- Identifying virtual or physically distant community service opportunities

Scheduling

- Resource teachers will move to elementary student homeroom classes
- Arrival, instructional, lunch, recess, bathroom, handwashing, and dismissal schedules developed to optimize distance, cleaning and learning
